Implementation of the program was in collaboration with a humanitarian agency and the Bukit Barisan Military Command I.

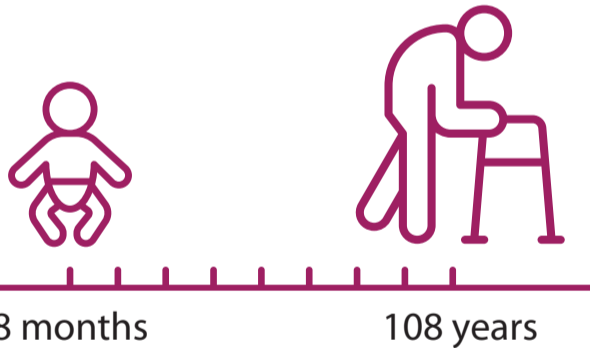


## The Program’s Objectives

A cataract is the leading cause of blindness in Indonesia



Every year, free surgery is performed not only for cataracts, but also for a handful of pterygium sufferers.



Since 2011, PTAR has facilitated ophthalmologists in North Sumatra to study at Tilganga Institute of Ophthalmology, Nepal to develop their capacity in fast cataract surgery technique from dr. Sanduk Ruit.

## Order of program execution

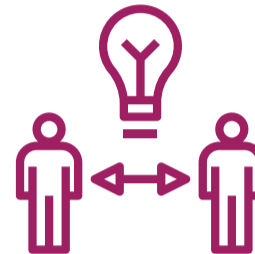


Free of charge. After surgery, the patients will be provided medicines, treatment manuals, and will be back for post-surgery eye exams.
