Since commencing production in 2012, Agincourt Resources has become an important contributor to regional development and Indonesia's mineral mining industry.

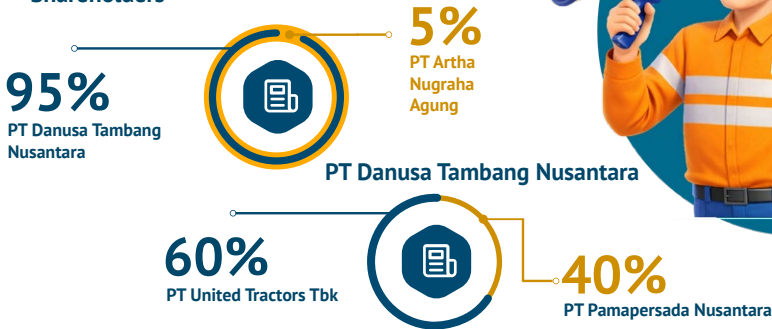
For us, mining is about more than extracting minerals. It is about caring for people, managing the environment responsibly, and contributing to a sustainable future.

Agincourt Resources has a multi-tiered ownership structure involving several shareholders through a layered corporate entity framework.

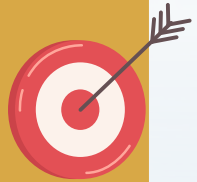

Preserving the Batang Toru Ecosystem

Batang Toru is home to one of Indonesia's richest and most important biodiversity landscapes.

Agincourt Resources implements conservation and environmental-management initiatives to support responsible operations and protect the surrounding ecosystem.

- ✓ Managing non-hazardous waste responsibly.
- ✓ Supporting the establishment of the Macaca Rescue Centre in collaboration with local conservation partners.
- ✓ Supporting the release of Sumatran tigers into their natural habitat in collaboration with the relevant conservation authorities.
- ✓ Restoring 29 hectares of mangroves habitat in Central Tapanuli.
* Supporting aquatic biodiversity through the release of shellfish and crab juveniles.
- ✓ Developing the Lubuk Larangan community conservation area.
- ✓ Developing arboreal bridges to support wildlife movement.
- ✓ Flora and fauna monitoring.
- ✓ Supporting sea turtle conservation in Muara Opu.
- ✓ Operating a nursery with an annual capacity of approximately 65,000 seedlings to support reclamation.
- ✓ Monitoring treated process water quality with communities and government through an integrated monitoring team.
